



The ICMHP is comprised of:

- The **Secretary of Human Services** of her/his designee
- The **State Superintendent of Education** or her/his designee
- The **Directors of the departments of Children and Family Services, Healthcare and Family Services, Public Health, and Juvenile Justice**, or their designees
- The **Attorney General** or her/his designee
- Up to 25 representatives of **community mental health authorities** and **statewide mental health, children and family advocacy, early childhood, education, health, substance abuse, violence prevention, and juvenile justice organizations or associations**, to be appointed by the Governor and 2 members of each caucus of the House of Representatives and Senate appointed by the Speaker of the House of the Representatives and the President of the Senate, respectively

The Illinois Children’s Mental Health Partnership (ICMHP) has the responsibility of developing and monitoring the implementation of the Children’s Mental Health Plan, as approved by the Governor. The Governor appoints the ICMHP Chair and designates a Governor’s staff liaison to work with the ICMHP.
